

MINUTES of the EXTRAORDINARY MEETING of
The DEVIOCK PARISH COUNCIL
held at the DOWDERRY METHODIST CHURCH on

Public Participation Period There being no members of the public present, the Chairman waived the public participation period.

1. APOLOGIES: Cllr. M. J. Crutchley and Cllr. Mrs. M. E. Temlett because of work commitments.

2. TO DEBATE THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION:

2.1 that in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted it is advisable in the public interest that the public be excluded and that they are instructed to withdraw.

Because no members of the public were present it was agreed not to debate this item.

3. CO-OPTION OF A NEW COUNCIL MEMBER:

3.1 To co-opt one Council Member to represent Seaton Ward, from the list of candidates who have asked to be considered and who are eligible to stand for office.
